Every Weekend, Quotas Exploded

A CPG brand ran weekly omnibus studies. Monday-Friday fielding was consistent. **Then came Saturdays.**

⚠ The Anomalies

- **Timing:** Uniform clusters (6:00-8:00 AM).
- **Speed:** 4-6 minutes (vs 12-18 min avg).
- **Volume:** 40% of weekly completes in 36 hours.



Saturday Morning Spike: 450 completes in 6 hours

Timing Never Lies

Blanc Shield's anomaly detection identified unnatural temporal patterns:

Hourly Distribution

Weekday: Normal bell curve.

Weekend: Unnatural sudden flood at 6AM & 2PM. Identical patterns on Sat/Sun.

Completion Speed

92% clustered between **4-6 minutes**. Statistically impossible for humans (Weekday median: 14 mins).

Device Rotation

Device A (6-7 AM) → Device B (7-8 AM).
Coordinated handoff, not random coincidence.

Conclusion

Not fraud. Coordinated. Automated.
Professional Click Farm.

Operational Tactics

- **Rotated VPNs:** Caught by geo-velocity.
- **Speed Optimized:** 4-6 min signature.
- **Generic Open-Ends:** No semantic markers.

Why Weekends?

Research Ops teams are smaller.

Automated systems checks are fewer.

Perfect window for undetected volume.

Before Detection: Real Damage

\$55k

DIRECT WASTE

\$340k

MISALLOCATED BUDGET

Data Quality Impact

⚠️ 63% of weekend responses were fraud.

⚠️ **Product Perception Inflated:** Farm gave generic "good" ratings.

Strategic Error:

Concept ranked #3 with farm data.
Actual market rank was #7.

How Blanc Shield Stopped the Farm

Time Anomaly

01

Weekend spike at 95th percentile flagged automatically by ML.

Device Cluster

02

47 devices rotating through predictable sequences.

Geo-Velocity

03

VPN hops in 60-second intervals = physically impossible.

Semantic Analysis

04

Matched known farm template library (99.2% similarity).

Cross-Panel Blacklist

05

All 47 devices banned across 5 suppliers instantly.

RESULT: Farm blocked in 48 hours | \$147k Saved

Why This Matters

1

Temporal Patterns Beat Rules

IP bans fail. Coordinated behavioral timing exposes automation.

2

One Farm, Multiple Suppliers

Farms diversify. Single-supplier visibility misses the operation.

3

Weekends Are High-Risk

Farms target monitoring gaps. Temporal flagging catches them cold.

Farms evolve. Static rules die fast.
